Day 1

- **Airport/Rly station Pickup, Guwahati to Shillong (110km/6hrs)**

On arrival, we will receive you at Guwahati and drive you to Shillong. The 4-lane road through beautiful hilly landscape is dream ride for any holiday-lovers. It is a pleasing 4 hrs journey from Guwahati Airport. There will be stopover at Umiam Lake which is a breathtaking beauty. You can have light refreshment with momo or soup or tea/coffee etc. If time allows we will be on a local sightseeing of the city including Police Bazar, Lady Hydari Park and Wards Lake etc. You can enjoy Khasi Food, Street food as Shillong is famous for its Chinese Cuisine. Stay in Shillong and enjoy the calm atmosphere of the Hotel. before we continue our drive. We check in at our hotel in Shillong. Day 2

Day 5

Upper Shillong to Nameri (330km/8hrs)

Today post breakfast we will start our journey towards Nameri. The fifth day of your Arunachal Pradesh travel takes you to the connecting force that binds North-East to the rest of India- the Kolia Bhomora Bridge. The Bhomora Bridge situated above the mighty Brahmaputra River has been a major contributor to North-East's development in terms of its connectivity to other parts of the country. This robust mass structure is not just known for its strength but also its beauty which gets illuminated in the red dusky sky (however, photography is not allowed there). Later, the day ends with a comfy stay at the hotel. you will be transferred to Nameri (200Km/5hr). After reaching **Nameri**, check in at hotel for your overnight stay.

Day 6

Nameri to Dirang (129Km/5hrs)

Early morning we will take you to Nameri National Park. Go bird watching and spot them in their vicinity, with more than 300 species of birds which also shelters rare and endangered "White Winged Wood Duck" also catch tiger in action as Nameri tiger reserve is under Project Tiger, it also homes wide verity of reptiles, fishes and mammals. Post breakfast, for adventure seekers and offbeat travellers go tracking and raft down Jia Borali River (smooth water rafting). After lunch will drive uphill to Dirang, entering Arunachal Pradesh "the land of raising sun". The place greets you with breathtaking valleys, misty rivers and stunning waterfall. After this enjoyable and memorable tour we will check in to the hotel at **Dirang** for a comfortable overnight



stay.

Day 7

Sangti Valley Tour

The afternoon unfolds as you venture to Mandala Top, a mystical destination revered for its spiritual significance and panoramic views. Just 26km away from Dirang, this place is adorned with 108 stupas. Mandala Top offers a sense peace and inner happiness, providing a captivating vantage point to appreciate the grandeur of the valleys and peaks. Explore the birding hotspot of Mandala Top, where the 108 stupas stand as a testament to the spiritual heritage of the region. Each stupa carries a unique energy, contributing to the serene ambiance of the area. Take a moment for introspection, absorb the spiritual vibrations, and capture the essence of this sacred place through your lens.

As the day concludes, return to your hotel at Dirang with the echoes of Sangti Valley and the spiritual aura of Mandala Top lingering in your memory. Check into your accommodation for a night of restful repose, rejuvenated by the day's exploration of nature's wonders and cultural treasures. Please note that Mandala Top sightseeing is subject to road clearance, ensuring your safety and a seamless travel experience on this captivating day of your Sangti trip.

Day 8

Dirang to Tawang (145km/6hrs)

Post breakfast, explore Dirang small hill station in west Kameng district. Its spectacular landscape and beautiful nature will surely please your eyes and comfort your body and soul. We will visit Kalachakra Gumpa also referred as Dirang Monastery and perceive the serene land. Witness kiwi orchids, then to Dirang Dzong (fort) which is about 150 years old and have an excellent view of the surrounding. Later proceed to Tawang, with mountain curve the river Kameng flow along. Witness Sela Pass, world second highest motor able road, with bright coloured flags fluttering all around at an altitude of 13,700ft. Know about Jaswant Garh memorial-cum-mandir. Enjoy spectacular Nuranang Fall (Bong Bong Fall), 100m height. After this pulsating and soul-stirring journey have a warm and comfortable overnight stay in **Tawang**.

Day 9

Around Tawang Sightseeing (150km/7hrs)

Post breakfast, start your day with breathtaking view of Shonga-tser Lake (Madhuri Lake), surrounded by snow-capped mountains and the valley offer a spectacular view. Next move on to Bum La Pass about 37km away from Tawang, it is the indo-china border that lies at 15,200 ft above sea level. On your way back stop by heart lake, PTSO lake, Naghula lake, which will surely make your day. After this return to your hotel for comfortable overnight stay in **Tawang**.

Day 10

Tawang to Bomdila (180Km/8hrs)

Post breakfast have a holly visit to Tawang Monastery (Galden Namgyal Lhatse), Asia's second largest and India's largest Buddhist Monastery which was build about 350 years ago in 17thCentury. Explore age old artefacts related to Tawang Monastery and Mompa people of Tawang. Get a picturesque view of Tawang township in the heart of sky-piercing mountains. Then we move on to The Tawang War Memorial, a beautiful stupa build in memory of the brave soldiers who sacrificed their lives in 1962 Sino-Indian war. Post Lunch, we move to **Bomdila** for a night halt.

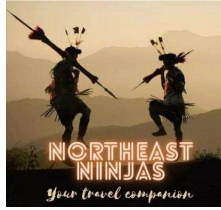

Day 11

Bomdila to Guwahati Via Shergaon (265km/7hrs)

Post breakfast, depart for guwahati via Shergaon, Bhairabkunda. Shergaon is beautiful small town. You will be spell bounded by the beauty of Shergaon village. You can have your lunch in this village. After that we will proceed to wards Bhairabkunda. It is situated on the border of Bhutan. The Jampani River, originating in Bhutan, and Bhairabi River merge here to form Dhanshiri River. Dhanshiri river is a major tributary of Brahmaputra river.From here if times allow, you can also visit Bhutan. After that we will start our journey towards Guwahati. . Finally we will drop you by Guwahati Airport in accordance and convenience of your departure time, with sweet memories.
