Itinerary

• Day 1

Airport/ Station pick up & transfer to Roing 140 KM/ 3 hours

On arrival at Dibrugarh Airport/ Tinsukia Railway Station, transfer to a comfortable coach. Drive to Roing itself is an attraction. This 3.5-hour drive on a black top road will make you criss cross through several beautiful tea gardens and the sight of Dr. Bhupen Hazarika Setu is just jaw-dropping. This river bridge is 9.15 km long that makes it the longest river bridge in India on water.

• Day 2

Roing to Anini 225 KM/ 7 hours

After breakfast, we start our journey to Anini. The range of Hills mainly in Lower Dibang Valley district and Dibang Valley district of Arunachal Pradesh are known as Mishmi Hills. Mishmi Hills are hot spot for Bird lover throughout the world. Birding activities generally remains restricted in the range from Roing to Mayudia. En route, we will stop at Mayudia Pass, where the landscape remains snow-capped for six months a year. Mayudia with a height of 2655 M above msl is the highest pass in the region. Every year in Dec - Feb, Mayudia experiences heavy snowfall. Continue your journey to reach Anini by Evening. Overnight stay at Anini homestay.

Today we will reach the crescendo of our trip, that is sinking in the beauty of nature at Anini and night stay at Chigu Camp.

• Day 4



Anini to Tezu

290 KM/ 8 hours

After breakfast at Chigu Camp, we will start our journey towards Tezu via Roing. This journey itself will be very exciting and you can make lots of pit stop for photography.

Night spend at a comfortable hotel at Tezu after the whole day journey.

• Day 5

• Tezu to Walong

190 KM/ 6 hrs

Tezu is headquarter of Lohit District and is the fourth largest town of Arunachal Pradesh. The tiny town of Tezu has a number of significant tourist attractions that include pilgrim spots, nature sites, historic monuments and scenic destinations. If you have time, then you may spend some, wandering the nearby attractions before driving towards Walong. En route, you get a sleepy township, Hayuliang, situated at the confluence of Lohit and Delai Rivers and has a breathtaking landscape.

The road is dotted with many waterfalls across Lohit River and exactly follow the serpentine and blue Lohit River. This is one of best journey through hilly terrain you can have. The sound of gushing white/ blue waters of River Lohit while crossing the truss bridges fill the heart with exhilarating emotion and the sight of the hanging bridges connecting distant hamlets brings a sense of contentment. En route, you may make quick pit stop at:

- Hawa Camp View Point.
- Chingminti Bridge
- Samdul Bridge
- Mompani Waterfall

In the evening, you reach the easternmost town of India, Walong. Night stay at Walong

• Day 6

• Kaho Village exploration and witnessing 1st Sunrise in India at Dong Valley

Kaho is home to around 100 villagers of the Meyor tribe who live in traditional Tibetan-style wooden huts. The village also has a nearly century-old Buddhist temple that overlooks the Lohit river and the ridges on the Chinese territory. Viewpoints in Kaho offer views of pine forests, misty mountains, and remote Chinese villages. Here are some things to see and do in Kaho:

- Embrace the first ray of Sun in India in Dong Valley. To witness this, you must start at 3:00 am from your hotel to the last motorable point. For an average walker, the trek to Dong to embrace the sunrise will take almost 90 minutes one-way.
- Tour the farms and gardens with the owners of the house. Hear the old men in the villages narrate eye-witness account of 1962 Indo-China War.
- Visit the Namti Plains, a hallowed ground which is an anecdote of a historic battle against the Chinese invaders from October-end to mid-November, 1962.



China recalls the defensive position as the “Tiger’s mouth”, because the Indian Forces stopped the Chinese advance to Walong despite being vastly outnumbered and outgunned.

- Spot birds found exclusively in the region.

Here are some things to see and do when you reach Kibitho:

- Walk across the hanging bridge
- Visit the Gompa (Buddhist Monastery)
- Spot birds found exclusively in the region.
- Count the Indian army bunkers across Indo-China Borders

Night Stay at Walong.

• Day 7

• Walong to Namsai via Parashuram Kund 236 KM/ 7 hrs

Morning starts with a magnificent journey towards Parashuram Kund. It is a shrine of all-India importance located in the lower reaches of the Lohit River. Thousands of pilgrims visit the place in winter every year, especially on the Makar Sankranti day for a holy dip in the sacred kund which is believed to wash away one’s sins. Apart from its spiritual side, you are sure to get awestruck by the sheer beauty of the landscape. We will then proceed to Brahmakund for some extraordinary roadside stops and photography.

In the evening (or next day morning), pay a visit to Golden Pagoda, the beautiful Buddhist Temple. The Golden Pagoda is a Burmese style Buddhist temple opened in 2010. The area of 49 acres is beautifully landscaped with gardens and also houses a centre for cultural research of the Tai-Khamti-Singpho tribes, a library and a monastery. The night view of Golden Pagoda, the *Kongmu Kham* in local language, is magnificent. Night stay at a homestay in Namsai

• Day 8

• Namsai to Tinsukia Rail Station/ Dibrugarh Airport 110 KM/2.5 hrs

Today after breakfast, depending upon your departure time from Tinsukia/Dibrugarh, you leave Arunachal Pradesh with lots of sweet memories. Our driver partner will drop you to the destination of your choice.
